

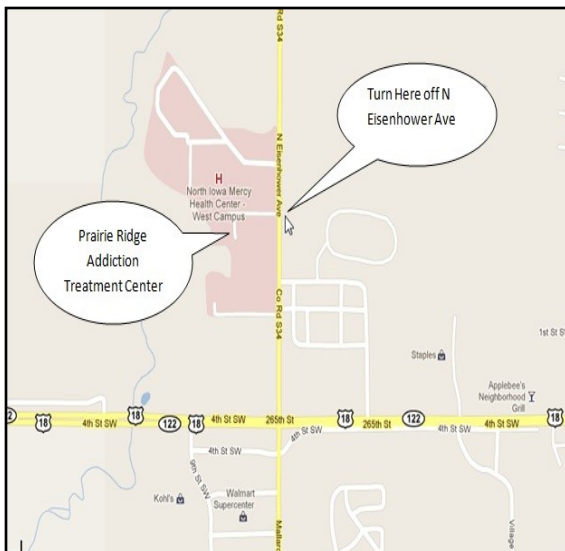
Directions

From I35: Take Mason City exit 194. Head east on Hwy 122. Turn north on Eisenhower Avenue.

From Avenue of Saints (Hwy 18/27): Take exit 183 onto Mallard Ave. N. This turns into Eisenhower Ave. Continue past Hwy 122 junction.

We are located in front of Mercy West Campus.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Prairie Ridge is a private, not-for-profit, community-based organization. Prairie Ridge accepts the following payment options:

- Payment for services from most major health insurance plans.
- Medicaid/Medicare reimbursement.
- Self-pay. Cash / All major credit cards.
- Sliding-scale fee available for Iowa residents only.

ASSESSMENTS:

Prairie Ridge offers assessments in the main office on a walk-in basis. We have walk-ins on Monday and Tuesday afternoons (arrive at 12:30 or 2 p.m.) and Tuesday and Thursday mornings (arrive at 8:30 or 10 a.m.). The walk-in format is designed to provide quick access.

PROGRAMMING:

With a strong commitment to a feedback-informed culture, Prairie Ridge utilizes evidence-based practices emphasizing flexible programming designed to meet the needs of the individual patient.

Skill-specific programming is available for individuals, and their families, who are struggling with a behavioral healthcare concern, including mental health, substance use, and gambling.

Treatment is offered at several different levels of intensity, including both outpatient and inpatient services.

MEDICATION/HEALTH NEEDS:

Prairie Ridge is committed to working with patients who have health concerns related to both physical and emotional health. We recognize that our patients benefit from coordinated care services with primary care providers, understanding the connection between substance use, mental health, and physical health disorders. It is our goal to work in cooperation with each patient's primary healthcare provider to better treat the whole person. In addition, Prairie Ridge employs an ARNP specializing in primary care who is located at the main campus.
